

The Warwickshire Badger Group



The Badger Group is a voluntary organisation dedicated to trying to protect this much loved, but often persecuted native British mammal. The Group works in close co-operation with the local police and is a member of the Badger Trust. Through a network of area co-ordinators its main aims are :-

- to help prevent cruelty to, & persecution of, badgers
- to prevent damage to, or destruction of, badger setts
- to help rehabilitate sick, injured, & orphaned badgers
- to collect & record details about Warwickshire's badger population.
- to help prevent the death or injury of badgers on the county's roads.
- to advise and inform the public about badgers
- to try and help resolve any local badger related problems
- to generally promote the all round protection of badgers

The Group provides members with a quarterly news letter. There is also the opportunity to attend free quarterly open meetings, where talks, short video presentations, and refreshments are provided. The Group also gives talks to other organisations. Members can also take a more active role in the work of the Group if they wish to.
